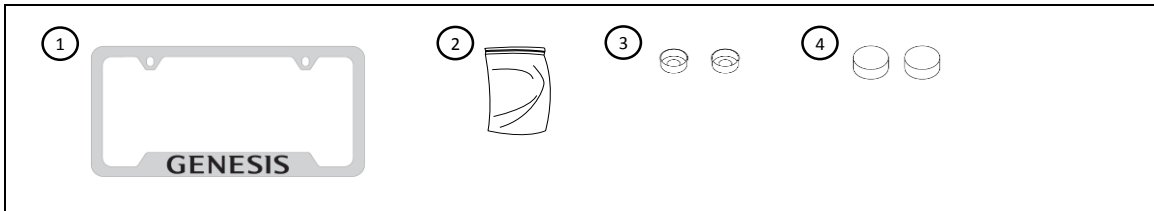

A black, fine-point, indelible marker must be used to write by hand onto the label, the reduced carrying capacity in kilograms or pounds, which is the total weight of all added options and accessories.

N O T E	Installation Overview	

2		#2 Phillips Screwdriver
		
N O T E	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Remove 2 (two) existing bolts or screws from the license plate and frame (if equipped), and remove from vehicle. 2. Discard the bolts or screws. 	

3		#2 Phillips Screwdriver
		
N O T E	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Align the License Plate Frame holes over the license plate and vehicle attachment holes. 2. Depending on vehicle configuration, install one (1) M6 Bolt or one (1) M5 Screw through one (1) Plastic Washer and through the License Plate Frame, license plate, and into vehicle attachment holes as shown. 3. Tighten the M6 Bolt or M5 Screw securely. Do not overtighten. 4. Repeat notes 2 & 3 for the other side. 	
	Make sure the M6 Bolt or M5 Screw fits inside of the Plastic Washer.

N O T E	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. At a slight angle, align one (1) Snap Cap over the Plastic Washer and push the Snap Cap until it snaps into place. 2. Repeat note 1 to install a Snap Cap on the other side. 	
	Make sure the Snap Cap is securely attached to the Plastic Washer.
