- For areas indicating the tightening torque in this instruction manual, tighten to the specified torque using a torque wrench. For areas in which the tightening torque is indicated inside parentheses (), the tightening torque is indicated as a reference value, however tightening using a torque wrench is not necessary.
- Do not modify the aluminum footrest kit.
- Do not install the aluminum footrest kit in any way other than described in the following instructions.
- If in any doubt, please ask your Mazda dealer to install the accessory in order to prevent errors in installation.
- If you have any questions about the use of the accessory, ask your Mazda dealer for proper advice before using it.



3. BEFORE INSTALLATION

REQUIRED TOOLS

- ☆Screwdriver (Phillips) ☆Trim removal tool ☆Torque wrench ☆Utility knife ☆Tape
- ☆Soft clean cloth ☆Electric drill (2.5 mm, 5 mm drill bits) ☆White marker
- ☆Loctite (Recommendation product: ThreeBond 1303N)

⚠ WARNING

Before performing any work, park the vehicle on level ground, apply the parking brake securely, and then block the wheels. If the vehicle moves while performing work, it could cause a serious accident.



⚠ CAUTION


Be sure to cover the vehicle body with protectors or mats prevent stains, scratches and damage when removing/installing the vehicle parts	parts. Use the correct tool for the job. 
4. VEHICLE PART REMOVAL


Front scuff plate removal

- Grasp the shaded area shown in the figure, detach tab A while pulling the front scuff plate in the direction of the arrow (1) shown in the figure, then detach the hook B, clip, and pin while pulling in the direction of the arrow (2).
- Grasp the shaded area shown in the figure, detach tab C while pulling the front scuff plate in the direction of the arrow
 shown in the figure, then detach the hook D, clip, and pin while pulling in the direction of the arrow (4).




Front side trim removal

- 1. Partially peel back the seaming welt.
- 2. Remove the cap nut.
- 3. Pull the front side trim in the direction of the arrow shown in the figure and remove it while detaching the clip.



MAZDA6, MAZDA CX-5 Front scuff plate removal


- 3. Grasp the shaded area shown in the figure, detach tab A while pulling the front scuff plate in the direction of the arrow (1) shown in the figure, then detach the hook B, clip, and pin while pulling in the direction of the arrow (2).
- Grasp the shaded area shown in the figure, detach tab C while pulling the front scuff plate in the direction of the arrow
 shown in the figure, then detach the hook D, clip, and pin while pulling in the direction of the arrow (4).




Front side trim removal

- 1. Partially peel back the seaming welt.
- 2. Remove the cap nut.
- 3. Pull the front side trim in the direction of the arrow shown in the figure and remove it while detaching the clip.

5. ALUMINUM PEDAL INSTALLATION





 Set the aluminum footrest temporarily before installation as shown in the figure. Then mark the mounting hole part by using on the base of R stop of the carpet. (2 point)








• Remove the aluminum footrest and then make a hole about diameter 7mm by utility knife at marking position of the carpet.












MAZDA6

- I. Remove the aluminum footrest.
- II. Wrap the drill bit with duct tape as shown in the figure.
- III. Set the drill speed to low.
 - Always use a drill with a rotation speed adjustment, otherwise the carpet may deform.
 - Be careful when handling drills and other sharp objects.
 - To prevent scratching and over-drilling, wrap the drill bit with duct tape.
 - When drilling the holes, be careful not to drill too deeply as there is sponge material on the underside.
- IV. With the drill bit pointed perpendicular to the accelerator pedal, drill a hole in the marked position in stages.
- V. Drill hole diameter: From 2.5 mm to 5 mm (1 location).
- VI. Remove any metal burrs around the drilled hole with a utility knife
- Make sure to remove burrs from the surface so that the surface of the footrest is smooth.

VII. Remove all shavings

- Completely remove drill shavings from the cabin; otherwise they may cause abnormal noise.
- Peel back the carpet and install the nut plate to the aluminum footrest installation areas on the underside of the carpet. When installing the nut plate, locate the notch of "V" in the bottom side.



- 4. Set the aluminum footrest to the footrest.
- 5. Apply a Loctite at the tip of the screw (2).
- 6. Install the aluminum footrest using the screw (2).

Screw tightening torque: 1.0-1.4 Nm

7. After installing the accelerator footrest. Install the vehicle part in the reverse order of removal.

-TO THE CUSTOMER-

- Please check that there are no slack or vibration of screw. Periodical inspection is required.
- Please be careful of the following points for taking care of this product.
 - 1. Please do not use hard tools, such as brush when you wash this. It may damage the surface.
 - 2. Please wash the product with water after using thinned neutral detergent, when it is hard to clean off by washing without soap.
