Care and Cleaning

- Components can be cleaned with a variety of mild soaps or automotive cleaning products
- Rinse trays thoroughly with water and allow them to dry before reinstalling.

Usage Notes

Manufacturer will not be responsible for any damage to product or vehicle due to accident or misuse.

Your cargo tray is designed to transport normal cargo contents. Flammable or dangerous materials should not be transported in your vehicle at any time. If any corrosive chemicals are spilled on your cargo tray it should be cleaned as described in the Care and Cleaning section.

Large rear section is designed to accommodate power lift gate and non-power lift gate vehicles. Non-power lift gate will have a small area on the driver's side that the cargo liner will not cover.

WARNING

Static electricity can cause an explosion of flammable liquid, vapor or gas in any vehicle or trailer. To reduce risk of serious injury when filling containers:

-Always place container on the ground before filling. -Keep the nozzle in contact with the container while you are filling it.

-Use only approved containers for flammable liquid.
