




■ PRECAUTIONS

- Be sure to apply the parking brake securely. Remove the ignition key from the key cylinder.
- · Apply chocks to the wheels.
- Set the shift lever in "P" (parking) position.

INSTALLATION PROCEDURES


A. REMOVING THE STANDARD SHIFT KNOB



1) Turn the standard shift knob counterclockwise and remove it.

Check

B. INSTALLING THE ALUMINUM SHIFT KNOB




1) Screw in the aluminum shift knob ① clockwise. When it becomes hard to turn, position the logo on the knob toward the rear of the vehicle.



Note

When the shift knob is tightened sufficiently, the clearance under the shift knob should be as indicated in the drawing as a reference.



Check

C. CHECKING AFTER INSTALLATION

- Firmly depress the brake pedal. With the ignition switch set in the "ON" position, move the shift lever and check if there is no looseness.
- Confirm that the shift lever functions correctly.

Check

REINSTALLATION OF STANDARD SHIFT KNOB

- 1) Unscrew and remove the aluminum shift knob.
- 2) Screw in the standard shift knob.
- 3) Check the shift knob for looseness.

CARE AND HANDLING



This aluminum shift knob may become hot in accordance with the temperature increase in the cabin.

- · Before driving, check that the shift knob is securely tightened.
- To clean this product, wipe with a dry and clean soft cloth. Do not use any solvents or abrasive.
