This product is an adapter for controlling iPod. When the head unit has the CD changer control function, It regards an iPod as a CD changer by connecting to the iPod.

The basic operations are described below. Depending on the function of the head unit to be connected, the basic operations may differ slightly.

Press the CD button of the head unit to select the CD changer mode, so the iPod is selected, and the song starts to play.

Note:

About resume play

This adapter corresponds to resume play of iPod.

Resume play is the function to start from the position where the user had listened last time when iPod is connected to this adapter. In this case, the disc number of the head unit is indicated "1". When an album is selected, or the random or scanning operation is executed, the resume play is canceled, and the first song of the album recorded in the iPod starts to play.

About indication on head unit.

The following restrictions exist by the display ability of the head unit.

- *The range of the display of the DISC number of the head unit is $0 \sim 9$.
- Therefore, the 10th playlist/album is displayed as "0".
- The display since the 11th repeats $1 \sim 0$. However, all PLAYLIST/ALBUM can be actually selected.
- *The range of the display of the TRACK number of the head unit is $1 \sim 99$.

Therefore, can not be displayed correctly since the 100th. However, all songs can be actually selected.

Selecting album

Albums may be selected by using PRESET BUTTON Ch.5 and Ch.6.

The operation varies by the mode set at initial setting.

•Album mode

Press PRESET BUTTON Ch.6 to select the next album, and press PRESET BUTTON Ch.5 to select the previous album. When only one album is recorded, these button are not operable.

All songs mode

Press PRESET BUTTON Ch.6 to track up 100 songs. Press PRESET BUTTON Ch.5 to track down 100 songs.

Selecting track

Press TRACK SELECT (UP/DOWN) BUTTON.

•PRESS UP BUTTON to play the previous track.

•PRESS DOWN BUTTON to play the next track.

Press and hold TRACK SELECT (UP/DOWN) BUTTON to fast forward or fast reverse.

Repeat
