



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. DESCRIPTION:** Disc Brake Pad Kit
- 2. APPLICATION** Refer to the Dealer Accessory Chart for specific vehicle application.
- 3. PART NUMBER:** Refer to the Dealer Accessory Chart for specific vehicle part number.

5. TOOLS REQUIRED:

- Wrench(21,19,17,14,12,10mm generally)
- Needle nose pliers
- Torque wrench
- Brake piston spreader

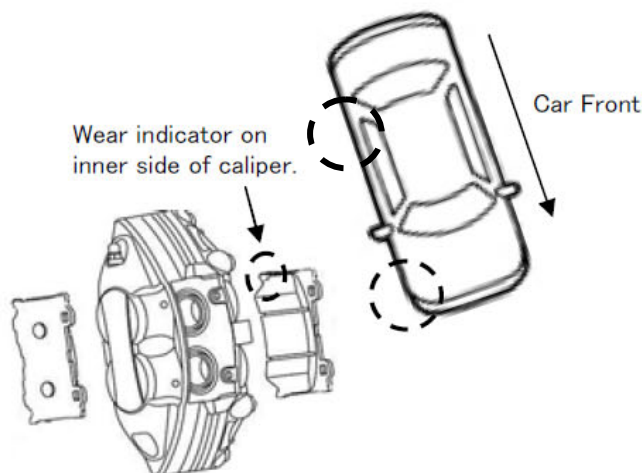
6. PRE-INSTALLATION CAUTIONS/NOTES:

- Dealer Installation Recommended. Instructions refer to Service Manual.
- Installation requires special tools.
- The accessory brake pads use a higher friction material than the original brake pads. Therefore, depending on your driving habits, you may experience more aggressive brake pad and rotor wear.
- Due to the use of a higher friction material, in cold start condition you may experience more break noise than usual.

⚠ CAUTION

Use protective gloves during the removal, installation, and inspection of the disc brake pad kit.

Install the disc brake pad(with wear indicator) to the inner side of the passenger side caliper when the amount of it is one.



7. PROCEDURE:

1. Remove the original disc brake pads and install the accessory disc brake pads by referring to the "BRAKE PAD : Removal and Installation" section of the service manual.
2. Inspect the accessory disc brake pads by referring to the "BRAKE PAD : Inspection" section of the service manual.
