

TOOLS REQUIRED: No Tools Required			
PRE-INSTALLATION WARNINGS, CAUTIONS, CRITICAL STEPS, and NOTES:			
 Vehicle cover must be installed properly and completely. Do not use vehicle with cover installed. 			
• Wash cover on vehicle with mild soap. Allow sufficient time for cover to air dry completely before storing. DO			
NOT use bleach!			
• If your vehicle is equipped with a cellular phone antenna, remove mast before installing cover.			
• Some states require license plate number of a covered vehicle to be clearly displayed.			
• Do not use: regular paint, spray paint, laundry markers, permanent type Magic markers, or any type of felt tip			
`pen or marker.			
 The only type of marking paint acceptable for use on this material is a permanent type fabric/t-shirt paint that is available at most fabric and supply stores. 			
 In high winds (and for prolonged outdoor storage), cover should be pulled tightly at center of vehicle using a 			
 In high whos (and for prolonged outdoor storage), cover should be pulled tightly at center of vehicle using a length of rope routed through tie-down grommets in cover. This should be done even if optional cable lock is 			
used. The cover can work loose and come off vehicle if a strong wind goes under the cover.			
• Do not place vehicle cover over hot exhaust pipes.			
• Do not use this cover while towing a vehicle. The cover is not designed for use when towing and serious damage			
can occur to the cover and to the paint on the vehicle.			

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:



- 1) Installation of vehicle cover:
 - a) Unroll cover and position so Nissan logo is at front of vehicle.

- b) Install antenna pocket over antenna.
- c) Install mirror pockets over mirrors.

d) Pull cover down over front and rear bumpers and adjust if necessary.

- 2) Removal of vehicle cover:
 - a) Release both ends of cover from under bumpers.
 - b) Fold both sides of vehicle cover toward center of vehicle making approximately 2 or 3 feet wide.
 - c) Start at front of vehicle and roll cover from front to the back.
 - d) Store cover in storage bag.

NOTE

Take care not to damage antenna during installation and removal of vehicle cover.

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE: (continued)

- 4) Washing and Cleaning:
 - a) Machine Washing and Drying (Cover may be washed using a household washing machine and dryer):
 - 1) Use a powder type detergent without bleach.
 - 2) Wash cover using "Normal" or "Permanent Press" cycle in cold or warm water.
 - 3) Run cover through (2) rinse cycles it is important that all detergent is removed.
 - 4) Cover can be dried in most household dryers. Use "Permanent Press" setting.
 - b) On-Vehicle Washing and Drying:
 - 1) Dust can be cleared off inside or outside surfaces by putting cover on vehicle and hosing it off with water. To clean inside, put cover on vehicle inside-out and hose off.
 - 2) After rinsing off cover, leave it on vehicle to dry.
 - 3) If cover becomes soiled in a few spots, light brushing with a soft rag will remove most dirt.

c) For Persistent Soils:

- 1) Wet soiled area with water.
- 2) Wash with a mixture of water and powder detergent, working lather into soiled area with a sponge.
- 3) Rinse completely with water to remove all detergent residue.
- 4) Air dry completely.
