




## **TOOLS REQUIRED:**

None.

## PRE-INSTALLATION WARNINGS, CAUTIONS, CRITICAL STEPS, and NOTES:

- Dealer Installation Recommended. Instructions may refer to Service Manual.
- Removal and Re-Installation of Cross Bars requires purchase of new M6 bolts (999R1 XZ500-S1) or the re-application of Thread locking adhesive such as LOCTITE® 242® or equivalent.
- Do not attempt to adjust fasteners on the underside of the brackets. Fasteners are pre-adjusted to the proper torque requirement by the manufacturer.


#### **INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:**



• If plastic plugs are installed in roof rail, Please Uninstall plastic plugs in roof rails as shown in Fig.1.


#### NOTE:

Stow plastic plugs for future use if crossbars will be removed.




# **A** CAUTION


- Make sure sunroof is in closed position during installation process.
- Arrow points forward.



- Each cross bar marked with "FR" or "RR".
- Front (FR) cross bar installed on side rail in front of rear doors.
- Rear (RR) cross bar installed on side rail behind rear doors.

#### **INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:**





# **A** CAUTION

 Protect painted area on the vehicle roof under crossbars by placing a piece of cloth under crossbars to prevent scrach damage.

Make sure that cross bar is properly in place on side rail with attaching holes / slots positioned over rivet nuts before tightening to specifications. 8-9N-m (71-80 in-lbs)

- 1) Loosely install all 4 bolts on front (FR) cross bar.
- 2) Secure forward bolt on driver side first and then secure remaining 3 bolts to proper torque (Fig 4).
- 3) Repeat procedure for rear (RR) cross bar.
- 4) make sure that bottom surface of cross bar bracket is flush with bottom surface of side rail prior to tightening bolts (Fig 5).
- 5) Place TORX key and instruction template in polybag and keep in vehicle glove box.
