


DESCRIPTION: HITCH MOUNT 2 BIKE CARRIER



CAUTION: ATTACHMENT HARDWARE CAN LOOSEN OVER TIME. CHECK AND TIGHTEN IF NECESSARY, BEFORE EACH USE.

MAINTENANCE: USE NON-WATER SOLUBLE LUBRICANT ON BOLTS. USE A SOFT CLOTH WITH WATER AND MILD DETERGENT TO CLEAN PLASTIC PARTS.




DESCRIPTION: HITCH MOUNT 2 BIKE CARRIER


INSTALL TONGUE.

Push the tongue into the hitch plate, aligning the holes.



- 2
- Install hex bolt and a flat washer.
- Add a second washer, attach a nut.
- Tighten with firm pressure. If mast will not pivot once installed into the hitch receiver, slightly loosen nut.










4 **INSTALL LARGE BOLT, LOCK-WASHER, AND WASHER.**

• Install bolt, lock-washer, and washer from right side of receiver.






 TIGHTEN with wrench until fully tightened.










CRADLE POSITIONING

To slide cradles along the carrier arms, close cradle and stabilizer.

> Close cradles while loading bikes.



Arms will lock

into position.






DESCRIPTION: HITCH MOUNT 2 BIKE CARRIER

LOAD HEAVIEST BIKE FIRST.

- Always load first bike with chain away from vehicle.
- Compress cradles against stabilizer.




Always use the cradles closest to the vehicle.




Stabilize the bike 8 frame in the cradle.

> Arrange bikes for best stabilization.



Pull straps tightly over frame diagonally, hook into place.

> The straps can be routed under the cables.




10 LOAD REMAINING BIKES.

Alternate bike directions to avoid interference.

Stabilize bike, secure with straps.

Install one ladder lock strap on each wheel & bike frame to prevent tire rotation.

Note: 6ft cable can be used to secure bikes to rack using the two loops, and a padlock (padlock not included).









FOLD MAST DOWN TO ACCESS THE REAR:

- Unload the bikes.
- Pull release knob upward.
- Fold mast down.
- When finished be sure to bring mast back to the upright and locked position.











CAUTION: NEVER OPERATE VEHICLE WITH HITCH MOUNT IN FOLDED POSITION!

FOLD CARRIER ARMS WHEN NOT IN USE.

- Pull release lever forward.
- Pull up slightly on arms while pulling lever.
- Fold arms.

PERFORM SAFETY CHECKS

- Mast must be locked into place when operating vehicle.
- Be sure the straps are hooked securely over the bike frames.
- Replace straps if cracked or worn.
- Be sure all hardware is secured according to instructions.
- Do not let bicycle tires hang near vehicle's hot exhaust.



IF YOUR VEHICLE HAS A REAR HATCH:

On some vehicles. hatch interference is unavoidable. Use caution when opening your hatch.

Mast must be locked in place before loading bikes or moving vehicle!



MAINTENANCE

Use non-water soluble lubricant on moving metal parts. Use a soft cloth with water and mild detergent to clean rubber parts.



IMPORTANT LOAD LIMITS

Total weight, 90 lbs./41kg

— USE —

- Off-road driving is not recommended and could result in damage to your vehicle, hitch receiver, or your bikes.
- Do not transport bicycles with attached baby seats, panniers, wheel covers, full bike covers or motors.
- Not intended for tandem, or recumbent bikes.

- INSTALLATION -

- Do not install on trailers, campers, or mobile homes.
- Remove this rack before entering an automatic car wash, and when not in use.

This product is designed for a hitch receiver, Class II or greater. Some undersized receivers may not accept this product. If you do not know the capabilities of your hitch receiver, consult an automotive professional.

Attachment hardware can loosen over time. Check before each use, and tighten if necessary. Failure to perform safety checks can result in property damage, personal injury, or death.
